Matt. 28:18-20 & 2 Cor. 5:16-21

Remaining focused on the main thing is _____. We let lesser things _____ us. **2 Cor. 5:16-21** addresses this fact.

The Corinthians were at odds with Paul. After a visit to Corinth, Paul stated his plans to return, but his plans changed. The Corinthians charged Paul with _____ and with being _____. This text addresses the main reason he didn't return. He couldn't be distracted by _____ when God had charged him with one main thing, what he calls the ministry of _____. We call it the proclamation of the gospel, our Great Commission (**Matt. 28:18-20**).

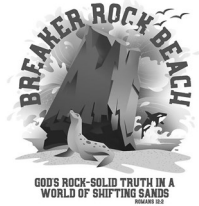
