Warning Signs

Matthew 24:32-41

In His message to His disciples in Matt. 24, Jesus spoke about some warning signs God gives. Verses 32-41 present a challenge. Jesus gives 3 illustrations, and the 1st seems to _____ the last 2. The fig tree illustration indicates that God _____ certain warning signs to help us know when and where God is getting ready to act. The next examples about Noah and the people working side by side are interpreted by Jesus to mean that God will _____ advanced warnings, so you just must be _____ at all times.

The best way to explain this seeming contradiction is to know that Jesus used the fig tree illustration to warn the disciples about the coming destruction of the _____ by the Romans. His last 2 illustrations are about His _____ and the _____ of the _____. Concerning that event, He says there will be no warning so _____ preparedness is the only reasonable thing to do.

If all of this seems a bit uncertain and even frightening to you, there is much good news here.
